## BISHOP DONALD J. HYING

A native of West Allis, Wisconsin, Most Rev. Bishop Hying was ordained a priest for the Milwaukee Archdiocese on May 20, 1989. There, he served in numerous parishes, as well as La Sagrada Familia in the Dominican Republic. Additionally, he served as dean of formation at Saint Francis de Sales Seminary where he was later appointed rector, serving there until Pope Benedict XVI named him auxiliary bishop of Milwaukee in 2011. On November 24, 2014, Pope Francis appointed Bishop Hying as the fourth bishop of Gary. His installation took place on January 6, 2015. He has produced numerous videos including ECHO, Crux/Blaze/Kenosis, and the C4-Ignite Your Catholic Faith.



## ROBIN ROCK

Robin Rock is the mother of three girls. For nearly two decades, Robin has been Chicagoland's companion at the workplace as a radio personality. She has been in the radio business for more than 20 years, beginning at a small station in Rensselaer, Indiana, as a part-time news reporter/station mascot. She is an avid runner and animal lover. ## FR. LEO PATALINGHUG

Father Leo Patalinghug is a priest member of a community of consecrated life, Voluntas Dei (Latin phrase that means "The Will of God"). This community is a Secular Institute of Pontifical Rite. He is the founder, host and director of Grace Before Meals, an international apostolate to help strengthen families and relationship through God's gift of a family meal. He is establishing a non-profit organization called "The Table Foundation," with the mission to elevate culture and family life, one meal at a time. Along with his priestly duties, Father Leo hosts the TV show Savoring our Faith on EWTN, co-hosts the radio show Entertaining Truth on Sirius XM Radio, is a bestselling author, contributor for newspaper and magazines, and is rated as one of the best speakers for the New Evangelization. Father Leo has been featured on ABC, CBS, NBC, PBS, EWTN, and even the Food Network, where he defeated a world famous chef in a cooking competition called, "Throw Down! with Bobby Flay." His message combines faithful Catholic theology presented in a way everyone can understand and appreciate. Using his background as a chef, a 3rd degree black belt martial arts teacher and award-winning choreographer for a break dancing group, Father Leo's presentations, retreats, parish missions and keynote talks have brought diverse audiences closer to the Lord's Table.
