The Church requires that a sponsor be:

- 1) A Baptized Catholic
- 2) A Confirmed Catholic
- 3) Reached the age of 16
- 4) If married, must be married in the Catholic Church
- 5) A practicing Catholic, which means registered as a member of a parish and regular attendance at Sunday Mass.

If Sponsor does not belong to OLPH, the pastor of the parish where the sponsor belongs must verify the person is a practicing Catholic. Simply ask your sponsor to call the parish's secretary for letter.
