In the Catholic Church only one person need be a godparent/sponsor. However, the person to be baptized may have to godparents. If there are to be two godparents one must be male and the other female.

If there are two godparents for this candidate we will need the following information on both godparents.

GODPARENT/Sponsor - The Church requires that a godparent/sponsor be:

- 1) A Baptized Catholic
- 2) A Confirmed Catholic
- 3) Reached the age of 16
- 4) If married, must be married in the Catholic Church
- 5) A practicing Catholic, which means registered as a member of a parish and regular attendance at Sunday Mass.

A parent cannot be a sponsor or godparent for their child.

If Sponsor does not belong to OLPH, the pastor of the parish where the sponsor(s) belongs must verify the person is a practicing Catholic. Simply ask your sponsor to call the parish's secretary for letter.
